As a result of inquiries from our US customers regarding the Conflict Minerals legislation Addressed in Section 1502 of the Dodd – Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act passed by the US Congress in July 2010, SVS-Vistek GmbH has implemented systems and processes in order to insure accountability in our supply chain which are subject of improvement as necessary to meet the Conflict Minerals requirements.

SVS-Vistek GmbH is committed to monitoring its supply chain to assure that Conflict Minerals directly or indirectly supporting civil violence or human rights abuses in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or adjoining countries are not used in the manufacture of SVS-Vistek products. SVS-Vistek GmbH does not purchase these minerals directly from the mines or smelters; therefore we rely on source information provided by our suppliers.

We will work with our preferred suppliers and contract manufacturers with the goal of providing our customers with the necessary assurances of the conformity with the Dodd – Frank Act, exercise due diligence on the origin, source and chain of custody of their Conflict Minerals.
